

Lady Mustang Softball remains unbeaten, Improves to 4-0

Conway, AR- The CBC softball team continued its unbeaten start to the 2010 season with a double header sweep of visiting Christian Brothers University Tuesday in Conway. CBC won by scores of 6-5 and 5-0.

In the first game CBC trailed 2-0 going into the bottom of the 4th inning until Hailey King led off with a solo homerun to get the Lady Mustangs on the board. CBC would go on to score 3 more runs in the inning with a 2 RBI single by Sam Baker, and a Christen Kirchner also drove in Brandi McChristian to make the score 4-2. CBU would add 1 more run in the 5th and 2 more in the 7th, but it was not enough as CBC added 2 runs in the bottom of the 5th on a 2 RBI double by Kirchner and that was enough to hold off CBU for the 6-5 win. Kirchner was 3 for 3 in the game with 3 RBI, Sam Baker added 2 RBI, and Hailey King was 2 for 4 with 1 RBI.

Jessica Bock improved to 2-0 on the season by pitching 7 innings, allowing 8 hits and 5 runs(3 earned runs), and she struck out 13 CBU batters.

In game 2, Senior Casey Hammons dominated the CBU hitters by only allowing 1 hit and she struck out 12 batters to improve to 2-0 on the season as well. CBC hitters would give her 5 runs in the game, Shannon Pickard scored on an RBI single by Sam Baker in the 2nd. Pickard would score again in the fourth inning after a double by Carly McLennan. CBC added 3 more runs in the 5th with RBI's by Pickard and McLennan once again. Pickard and McLennan were both 2 for 2 in the game to lead the Lady Mustangs.

CBC Softball travels this weekend to the Lyon College Invitational with games on Friday and Saturday in Batesville, AR.
