Career Opportunities

Elementary Education

An elementary teacher has the opportunity to concentrate on a grade level and teaches all subjects to that grade. The grade span is typically K-4, but may include 5th or 6th grade. A true focus at elementary is in grade-level reading and writing. Reaching students at this younger age helps them move toward appropriate development.

Middle Level Education

A middle level teacher has the opportunity to focus on a subject and begin to develop deeper exploration into that subject. Middle level may include grades 5-8 where teachers help students develop social skills they will need to be successful later in life. These skills include collaboration, communication, critical thinking and problem solving.

Secondary Education
