



Puerto Rican Stipend/Scholarship

Individuals from Puerto Rico may be eligible for a financial aid package consisting of Federal and Institutional aid at Central Baptist College.

If students from Puerto Rico would like to attend CBC, they will fall under the following guidelines set by Central Baptist College.

1. Mandatory housing and meal plan (**\$8,500 annually**).
2. Mandatory 15 credit hours per semester
(**@\$660.00 per credit hour = \$19,800 annually**).
3. General Fees = **\$2,500- \$3000**
 - a. Base Fees-**\$1,530**
 - b. Book Fee (\$21 per credit hour)-**\$630**
 - c. Athlete Insurance-**\$500** (billed in fall only)
 - d. Total annual cost: **\$30,960**

Students from Puerto Rico may be eligible to receive the new Central Baptist College “**US Territories Stipend**” of **\$8,000**, deducted directly from the annual cost, making the amount owed **\$22,800** for the year. In addition, for those who meet the qualifications, and additional **\$4,000** scholarship could reduce the total to as little as **\$18,800**.

Students from Puerto Rico must apply for Federal Student Aid (federal grants, workstudy, and loans) by completing the online *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FASFA) at fasfa.gov.”

Below is a list of miscellaneous fees that may apply:

Science labs, application fee, housing deposit, tuition deposit, music fees, books, etc.
