### **Privacy Act:**

Notification of privacy rights under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act  
*General Education Provisions Act, Sec. 438, Public Law 90-247, Title IV, as Amended*

- I. Subject to limitations specified in the act, eligible students are assured the following rights pertaining to their educational rights:
