Flexible Degree Options

In addition to Traditional Classes, Central Baptist College also offers the unique PACE Program.

The PACE program offers working adults an opportunity to earn a college degree.

Most of our PACE students either left college or never had a chance to start college because of family or job obligations. However, they all realize the value of a college education.

Unlike many traditional programs, the PACE program was designed to meet the needs of busy working adults, no matter what their age or education level. First-time entering student or transferring from another institution.

Classes are typically taken one night per week, last five weeks each, and are offered in-person, online, or a hybrid of the two. Students have four five-week 'blocks' each semester, and can take up to 18 hours of credit classes each semester toward a Bachelor's degree.

Who is an Ambassador?

- ▶ People like you! Central Baptist College alumni and friends who are committed to engaging with prospective CBC students for the purpose of strengthening the college's enrollment.
- ▶ You are a vital part of our recruitment team. No one knows better the challenges and rigors of attending school than someone who has been there.
- ▶ Your success in the program will give others the encouragement to do the same for themselves.
- ▶ You are the ones who can encourage them along this path to a college degree.
- ▶ Your experiences at CBC speak volumes to those who are contemplating this path to higher education.



Why do we need Ambassadors?

- ▶ We need your help in locating and interacting with prospective students.
- ▶ Your experience at CBC is encouragement to anyone who has a desire to achieve their goals of a college education no matter if they just graduated high school or have been out of school for 40 years.
- ▶ Because you have walked in their shoes and understand their needs as a potential student. You have been a student at CBC. You have credibility when you speak of your experiences here.
- ▶ Because your life experiences will have you in places we are not, and may never be.
- ▶ Because your circle of influence is different from any other persons making you uniquely qualified to represent CBC as an Ambassador.
- ▶ Marketing studies show that ‘word of mouth’ is one of the most trusted and effective forms of advertising.
- ▶ The mission of Central Baptist College is relative and glorifies our Almighty God.

How can I be an effective Ambassador?

- ▶ First and foremost, pray that God would use CBC for His glory and continue to transform lives through academic excellence in a Christ-centered environment.
- ▶ Be willing to serve and sign-up.
- ▶ Talk to your family, friends, co-workers, church staff, anyone you know that would benefit from a Christian education. In other words—Anyone who will listen.
- ▶ We will provide you with the tools to be an effective member of our recruitment team. You send them to our trained Admissions staff, and we will do our best to help them reach their goals.

Church Partner Role

- ▶ It is critical to the mission of CBC to find and support BMA churches, as well as other similar denominational churches, that are willing to reach out to their students on behalf of CBC.
- ▶ We believe your connection to both the youth and adults in your local church is a key factor in helping them make wise choices about the college decision-making process. We also believe that CBC can offer students a wonderful opportunity to continue their education in a Christ-centered atmosphere where academic excellence and Christian leadership development are our top priorities.
- ▶ Your role is critical in the lives of training up committed followers of Jesus, and we need you to help provide information about CBC to the potential students in your sphere of influence. If you are a member of a church staff or are an involved layperson in a community of believers, then this might be an opportunity for service.

How you can help

The following are opportunities that you will have as a Church Partner to promote CBC:

- ▶ Host CBC staff, faculty and students for helpful college information sessions with interested prospective-students and parents.
- ▶ Promote and host a "CBC Sunday".
- ▶ Talk about CBC's PACE program with the adult membership. You will have the opportunity to talk to them about PACE's flexible block schedule and evening course offerings available in person or online.
- ▶ Refer potential student prospects to the Office of Admissions through cbc.edu/referral.

Communication Partner

- ▶ **Communication Partner-** Every Ambassador is a Communication Partner, and your role is to begin the dialogue with prospective students. These types of communications can be done over a cup of coffee, in a church pew, at the gym, or at the copy machine.
- ▶ **Personal Communication-** Make is personal. Tell your story. They want to hear why you chose CBC and what was your experience like while you are here. Talk to them about what CBC has to offer them. Your experience will encourage them along their own path.
- ▶ As you engage with individuals in your daily life try think of ways to start the conversation about their education and your testimony of your experience at CBC. As our Ambassador we need you to promote CBC within your circle of influence, people you work with, go to church with and do life with. Engage in a conversation with them about their educational goals. Do they have a dream of going to school? What is stopping them? How can CBC make that dream a reality?
