

Housing F.A.Q's

When can I move in?

New Students: Saturday, August 17 from 9am-3pm

Returning Students: Tuesday, August 20 from 9am-3pm

If you are on the SOS, the Volleyball team, or Soccer team, please contact your coach/sponsor to find out your designated move in times.

*It is important to move in during these specified times. If you absolutely cannot move in during the appropriate time frame, you must contact CBC Housing department in advance to make other arrangements.

** You must be registered for classes, have an updated housing contract on file, pay your housing deposit, and **make ALL payment arrangements with the business office BEFORE** moving into the Residence Halls.

What can I expect on move in day? When you arrive ***before you unload anything*** head to the check in station at the College Avenue campus entrance. We will verify that we have a completed housing application and contract, your housing deposit, that you are registered for classes, and have made payment arrangements with the business office. You will then get your Student ID. After everything is complete, you will then be escorted to your room by a member of the Housing Staff where you will complete a Resident Entry Form. After this is completed you will receive your room key! At that point the SOS staff will be available to help you move in. Move in day is the first of many events of "M.U.D. Week." Be sure to check the schedule or ask an SOS member about upcoming M.U.D. Week events!

What if I still need to pay my deposit? You may pay online at www.cbc.edu through PayPal, or send a check for \$150 made payable to Central Baptist College or you may visit the Admissions Office on campus to make your payments. You will not be able to check into the residence halls until the housing deposit is paid and payment arrangements are made with the business office for your entire school balance. To assure that the move in day goes smoothly, we ask that you please visit the business office prior to move in day.

What can I bring?

Small refrigerator (must not exceed 3.7 cubic feet)

Coffee maker

Microwave

Pictures of Family

TV, stereo, computer, movies, games

*Linens and towels (standard twin size beds)

*Shower curtain

*Cleaning supplies (you will need supplies to clean your tile/hardwood floor and bathroom)

*Medicine, toiletries, and first aid supplies (don't forget toilet paper)

Additional furniture??? (Dickson Hall is completely and fully furnished and space for additional furniture is very limited. Additional furniture in the CBC houses vary.

*Necessary items

What should I leave at home?

Open element appliances (toasters, hot plates, broilers, open coil space heaters, grills)

Halogen Lights or Sun Lamps

Candles

Dart boards

Air Conditioners

Anything that promotes or advertises violence (this includes airsoft and paintball guns), drugs, alcohol, or pornography

What are the dimensions of the rooms?

Dickson Hall: 12'x11' and 10' x 11'

What size are the beds? Standard twin

What if I want to switch roommates or rooms? Changes can be made September 3 - 6 by submitting a request to your Residence Life Staff. No changes will be made before or after those days, unless the Resident Coordinator feels a resident should be moved for health or safety reasons.

When is curfew? Curfew is Monday-Thursday night at Midnight. There is no curfew on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday nights. Curfew will begin Wednesday, August 21.

Do I need a meal plan? All students living on campus automatically receive all 19 meals in the Dining Hall.

If you live off campus or have a visitor come to visit, Dining Services do offer meals to the public for a reasonable price.

We also have Café 52 where anyone can purchase snacks and meals at their convenience.

What furniture comes in the rooms? Each room in Dickson Hall will have a standard twin size loft bed, a wardrobe with drawers for each resident, a desk with mobile drawers (to be used for desk or as additional dresser) for each resident, and private bath. **No furniture can be removed.** Each room in the CBC houses will have a standard twin size bed. Other furniture will vary depending on the house assigned.

How do I get in the residence hall if the doors are always locked? You will get an ID at check-in. For Dickson Hall, all residents will swipe your card in the reader near each door to gain access. For the CBC houses, each resident will receive a key to the house.

How can I decorate? You are encouraged to bring things to the room to make it feel like home. You may not hammer or screw anything new into the walls. Command strips will be the only thing allowed to use on the walls to hang items. Please do not use double sided tape or items that may damage the paint. If you do not follow these guidelines, you will be charged for all damages to the wall. You may also bring throw rugs to lay in your rooms but do not attach them to the floor in any way. (Dickson hall has hardwood. CBC Houses vary.)

Can I have guests spend the night? Permission must be obtained from your Residence Assistant by NOON on the day of the visit to have an overnight guest.

What is the Residence Hall Opening and Closing Schedule? When the Residence Halls closes, you must check out properly and not return to the hall until it reopens. We will assist you in finding a host family over breaks when needed.
