



Central Baptist College's Transfer Guide for the Missionary Baptist Seminary
Effective from 01/01/2016 through 06/30/2017

This guide is based on a review of courses offered by the Missionary Baptist Seminary in Little Rock, Arkansas, and is subject to review and modification at any time and without prior notice. This guide does not include all courses offered by the Missionary Baptist Seminary, but it does include some lower-level courses that when successfully completed at the Missionary Baptist Seminary will transfer to Central Baptist College. A grade of C or higher is required for all courses transferred to Central Baptist College. Courses accepted in transfer may not be applicable to the academic program chosen by the student. The number of credits granted for any course equivalency may not exceed the number on the transcript associated with the transfer course. In some cases, more than one transfer course may be required to meet equivalency. Although a lower-level transfer course might be deemed equivalent to an upper-division course at Central Baptist College and accepted for transfer, it may not count toward the total upper-division requirement for a degree. Curriculum changes at either institution may affect transferability and applicability of certain credits.
