Privacy Act: Notification of privacy rights under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act

General Education Provisions Act, Sec. 438, Public Law 90-247, Title IV, as Amended

- I. Subject to limitations specified in the act, eligible students are assured the following rights pertaining to their educational rights:
 - A. The right to inspect and review their records, to request reasonable explanations and interpretations of them, and to obtain copies of them
 - B. The right to seek correction of the records through a request to amend them or through a formal hearing
